CLASS SPECIFICATIONS

FEATURED CLASSES

HUNTER CLASSIC Beginner Rider, 18", 2', 2'6" and 3'. Open to all riders and horses or ponies. The class/classes will be conducted over *two rounds* scored on the open numerical judging system. **The first rounds will be a part of most hunter divisions.** In order to meet the ETHJA requirement for double points, the class will be conducted as five separate classes with Classics at: **18" (one each for Beginner Riders and Mini Hunters), 2', 2'6" and 3'.** In each Classic section, following the first round in their chosen division, riders will ride their second round in reverse order with the highest score riding last. **Riders must indicate on their Fiesta Farm entry for which of the following hunter divisions their double points will apply (for year-end ETHJA purposes only): Mini, Schooling, Pre-Child/Adult, Short Stirrup, Long Stirrup, Pony, Low, Adult Amateur, Children's or Performance Hunter.** An asterisk marks the individual class in each division from which the initial score may come. Riders must show in, and complete the class in, one of the over fences rounds in their chosen division (as per USEF rules) but may ride in any other division for which they are otherwise eligible. The combined numerical score from both rounds of each of the five sections, (Beginner Rider and Mini Hunter 2', 2'6" and 3) will be tabulated. Individual classes at each of the heights will be placed through sixth and each winner will receive a special award. Riders will ride for ribbons in each section and may participate in a victory gallop. Formal attire for the Classic is encouraged but is not required. Entry fee \$20.

EQUITATION CLASSES

LEAD LINE EQUITATION: Open to riders six years and under. Must be in riding attire but not necessarily full show attire. To walk only.

GROUND RAIL EQUITATION: Open to amateur and junior riders who have not shown over fences. Courses must be trotted. Cantering poles will be penalized. Riders may cross enter in the Cross Rail Division. To be judged on riders' ability to effectively control the horse. To be shown over a simple course of ground rails twice around.

14 & UNDER EQUITATION: Open to riders 14 and under on horses or ponies. Fences 2' or 2'6".

15-17/ADULT AMATEUR EQUITATION: open to rider 15-17 or adult amateurs. Fences: 2'6" or 3'.

ETHJA CHILDREN'S MEDAL: Open to junior riders on horses. To be shown over a course of fences with at least two changes of direction. A flat phase is required and shall count 25%. Further testing from USEF tests 1-12 may be requested at the judge's discretion. The top fifteen qualifiers at the end of the season will be eligible for a special ETHJA-sponsored Medal Finals. Fences: 2'6" or 3'.

ETHJA ADULT MEDAL: Open to adult amateur riders on horses. Same specifications as above. Fences 3'.

ETHJA PONY MEDAL: Open to junior riders on ponies. Same specifications as above. Small ponies to jump 2', Medium ponies 2' or 2'6", large ponies to jump 2'6".

MISCELLANEOUS CLASSES

RED/BLUE WARM-UP: Open to any horse/pony/rider combination. The judge will award a red ribbon for good rounds and a blue ribbon for excellent rounds, at his/her discretion. Red, blue or no ribbon will be awarded to each rider immediately after the completion of their round. **Multiple rounds** may be ridden (and paid for) as time permits.

PLEASURE DIVISION: Open to all riders on horses or ponies. To be judged as a pleasurable ride with manners and attitude to be taken into consideration. Hunter Hack may have two jumps of 18".

HUNTER CLASSES

MINI HUNTER: Open to all riders on horses or ponies. Fences at 18" or 2' over regular courses with a change of direction. No penalty for trotting on course: cantering encouraged. Under-saddle class to walk/trot only. In order to retain BEGINNER RIDER status, riders may NOT show at 2'.

BEGINNER RIDER HUNTER: To be shown over a simple hunter course including small flower boxes, walls and gates with a change of direction on course. To be held in the main show ring. Open to beginner riders on horses or ponies who have not shown over fences 2' or higher prior to the horse show. There will be no penalty for trotting on course or through lead changes. Under-saddle class to walk & trot only. To be judged on riders' control and consistency in rhythm and strides on course. Fences 18".

X-RAIL HUNTER: Open to amateur and junior riders who have not shown over fences 18" or higher. Courses to be trotted with no penalty for cantering "out" of each line. Under-saddle to walk/trot only. To be judged on the consistency and rhythm of the horses' stride on course. Riders may cross enter into the ETHJA Beginner Rider Hunter and Equitation as well as any flat classes. To be shown over a simple course of low cross-rails with no change of direction. Fences under 18".

SHORT STIRRUP HUNTER: Open to riders twelve years of age and under on ponies in their first or second year of showing over fences 2' or higher. Pony/rider combination may not cross enter the pony Hunter Division. Fences 2'.

LONG STIRRUP HUNTER: Open to any rider in their first or second year of showing over fences 2' or higher who is either: riding a horse; or is riding a pony and is older than twelve years of age. Riders may not cross enter the Short Stirrup Hunter Division. Fences 2'.

CHILDREN'S HUNTER: Open to junior riders on horses. Fences 3'.

ADULT AMATEUR HUNTER: Open to adult amateur riders on horses. Fences 3'.

LOW HUNTER: Open to all horses and ponies. Adults may ride ponies. Fences 3'.

SCHOOLING HUNTER: Open to all riders on horses or ponies. Fences at 2' or 2'6". This division will be split into two sections. Each horse/pony may compete in **ONLY ONE SECTION** of the class.

PONY HUNTER: Open to junior riders on ponies. Pony/rider combination may not cross-enter the Short Stirrup Hunter Division. Fences 2' for small ponies, or 2' or 2'6" for medium ponies, and 2'6" for large ponies. USEF rules to apply for ages of rider for each section.

PRE-CHILD/ADULT HUNTER: Open to children and adult amateur riders on horses. Fences 2'6"

PERFORMANCE HUNTER: Open to any horse or rider. Fences at least 3'3".

Food and drink will be available all day

on HORSE SHOW Sunday.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

ENTRY FEES for all regular classes and warm-ups will be \$15 per class. **ENTRY FEES** for the **Classics** will be \$20.

NEGATIVE COGGINS TESTS taken within twelve months must be available upon entering. Pony Cards for the Pony Division must also be available upon request.

USEF rules will apply in all classes & situations as modified by local conditions or rules as stated herein.

SUITABLE ATTIRE is requested for all classes in the main show ring. Suitable 'practice' clothing will be satisfactory in the lower ring. Formal attire is appropriate but not required for the Classics.

DOGS and other pets should not attend the horse show.

STABLING may be available upon request on the grounds for \$20 for Saturday night and all day Sunday beginning at 3:00 p.m. on Saturday. The course will be set and **SCHOOLING** allowed before the horse show Saturday afternoon from 3:00 p.m. until 7:30 p.m. Schooling fee is \$10 per horse, if you will not be showing on Sunday. Horses stabling at *Fiesta Farm* and/or showing at the horse show are exempt from the schooling fee.

Two entries are required to **FILL each CLASS**.

If there are insufficient entries in any class, it may be combined with another appropriate class or division. **MULTIPLE CARDS MAY BE OPEN DURING THE SHOW** up to a total of three judged classes plus a warm-up. In order that the show run smoothly and to make the show more efficient for exhibitors, classes that "go together" for an individual exhibitor may be ridden one after the other rather than waiting until the class' scheduled time table. However, **classes must be ridden in the correct order** as they appear in the schedule and only three classes may be running concurrently except for the Red/Blue warm up class that, while judged, is not ranked and scored for placing. Please see the schedule for classes affected and ask the gatekeeper at the show to help you if you are unfamiliar with this concept.

ASTM-SEI APPROVED HELMETS must be worn at all times when mounted.

MARTINGALES are not permitted in under saddle, equitation flat, or the flat phase of any Medal class.

UNCONVENTIONAL tack or equipment will only be permitted at the judge's discretion.

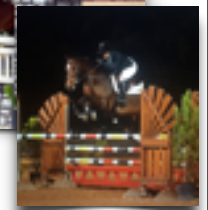
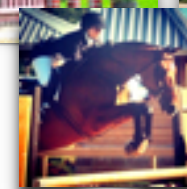
THE HORSE SHOW IS OPERATED in accordance with the current rules of the ETHJA. To be eligible for year-end awards, the exhibitor, the owner and the horse/pony must be registered with the association. Applications are available from the show secretary.

AWARDS

- ★ **RIBBONS** will be awarded in all regular classes through sixth place.
- ★ Championship winners shall each receive a **RIBBON** and a special award or **TROPHY**.
- ★ Reserve champion winners shall receive a **RIBBON**.
- ★ **CLASSIC** winners to receive a **SPECIAL AWARD**.
- ★ **ETHJA YEAR-END AWARD** points will accrue to ETHJA members and ETHJA- recorded horses and ponies in the following HUNTER divisions: Ground Rail Equitation, Mini, Beginner Rider, Short Stirrup, Long Stirrup, Pony, Schooling, Pre-Child/Adult, Children's, Adult/Amateur, Low, and Performance. Points will also accrue in the following EQUITATION divisions: Ground Rail, Beginner Rider, 2', 14 and under, 15-17, Adult Amateur as well as in all ETHJA medal classes. Points will also accrue for double points for CLASSIC ribbon winners in the division of their choice. The Pleasure Division is also an ETHJA year-end award division.
