AWARDS

- **RIBBONS** will be awarded in all regular classes through sixth place.
- Championship winners shall each receive a **RIBBON** and a trophy.
- Reserve champion winners shall receive a **RIBBON**.
- **ETHJA YEAR-END AWARD** points will accrue to ETHJA members and ETHJA- recorded horses and ponies in the following classes: PLEASURE classes; the HUNTER DERBY; the following HUNTER divisions: Beginner Rider; Mini; Short and Long Stirrup; Schooling 2'; Schooling 2'6"; Pony; Pre-Child/Adult; Children's; Adult Amateur.; Low; and Green. Points will also accrue in the following EQUITATION Divisions: Ground Rail; Cross Rail; Beginner Rider; 2'; 14 and under; 15-17; Adult Amateur; all ETHJA medal classes. Double points will also accrue from the HUNTER CLASSICS in the division of the rider's choice. NO ETHJA POINTS will be awarded for the LEAD LINE, or for FIESTA HUNTER.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

- **ENTRY FEES** for all classes held in the **MAIN RING**, except those specified below, will be \$15 per class. Classes held in the **PRACTICE RING** will be \$10 per class. **HUNTER CLASSICS** and **HUNTER DERBY** \$25. The **Lead Line** has no entry fee. Additionally, a \$20 per horse Office Fee will be added. Fiesta Farm horse shows offer HORSESHOWSONLINE in order to make entering and tracking entries convenient for all.
- **NEGATIVE COGGINS TESTS** taken within twelve months must be available upon entering. Pony Cards for the Pony Division must also be available upon request.
- **USEF rules** will be followed except as modified by local conditions and/or specific ETHJA rules. See ETHJA rules @ www.ethja.org/rules or USEF rules @ www.usef.org.
- **SUITABLE ATTIRE** is requested for all classes in the main show ring. Suitable 'practice' clothing will be satisfactory in the lower ring. ASTM-SEI approved helmets with harness are required when mounted.
- **TACK:** martingales are not permitted in any class "not to jump" or in the flat phase of a medal class. Unconventional bits and nosebands will be penalized at the judge's discretion.
- **DOGS** and other pets should not attend the horse show.
- **STABLING** may be available on the grounds and upon request for \$50 for the weekend beginning at 3:00 p.m. on Friday, or \$35 for a stall for either night. Paddocks may also be available. Please call ahead for availability. Priority will be given to horses attending the show from out of town.
- The course will be set and **SCHOOLING** will be allowed before the horse show on Friday afternoon from 3:00 p.m. until 7:30 p.m. The Friday schooling fee is \$10 per horse, if you **will not** be showing on Saturday or Sunday. Horses boarded at Fiesta Farm and/or showing at the horse show are exempt from the Friday afternoon schooling fee.
- Two entries are required to **FILL each CLASS** (ETHJA specs). If there are insufficient entries in any class, it may be combined with another appropriate class or division. Examples of divisions that may be combined are: Children's Hunter and Adult/Amateur Hunter; Short and Long Stirrup. The Pony Hunter, Beginner Rider Hunter or Equitation will be split if sufficient entries warrant.
- **MULTIPLE CARDS MAY BE OPEN DURING THE SHOW.** In order that the show run smoothly, classes that "go together" for an individual exhibitor may be ridden one after the other rather than waiting until the class's scheduled time table. However, **classes must be ridden in the order** in which they appear in the schedule. In addition, *only three classes may be running concurrently*, with the exception of the Red/Blue warm-up classes that, while judged, are not ranked and scored for placing. Please see the schedule for classes affected and ask the gatekeeper at the show to help you if you are unfamiliar with this concept.
- **RED BLUE WARM-UPS:** the judge may award, at his/her discretion, a red or blue ribbon for any warm up round that meets the judge's standard for good and exceptional rounds. Ribbons awarded will be announced after the round is completed. **Multiple warm-up rounds may be allowed only if time permits.** Please make sure that these rounds are entered in advance.

First rounds of the classics will come from the second round of each eligible division, except in the case of division including a HANDY class. In those divisions, the CLASSIC round will be the first regular hunter class. Classes are marked with an asterisk*.

CLASS SPECIFICATIONS

FEATURED CLASS

HUNTER CLASSIC: Classics will be offered for Beginner Rider, 18", 2", 2'6", 3'. Open to all riders and horses or ponies. The class/classes will be conducted over two rounds scored on the open numerical judging system. The first rounds will be a part of most hunter division. In order to meet the ETHJA requirements for double points, the classes will be conducted as five separate classes with CLASSICS at: 18" (one each for Beginner Rider and Mini Hunter), 2', 2'6" and 3'. In each Classic section, following the first round, in their chosen division, riders will ride their second round in reverse order with the highest score riding last. Riders must indicate on their Fiesta Farm entry for which of the following hunter divisions their double points will apply (for year-end ETHJA purposes only): Mini, Schooling, Pre-Child/Adult, Short Stirrup, Long Stirrup, Pony, Low, Adult Amateur, Children's Hunter. The second round in each division shall be the individual class in each division from which the initial CLASSIC score may come. Riders must show in, and complete that class as their over fences round in their chosen division (as per USEF rules) but may ride in any other division for which they are otherwise eligible. The combined numerical score from both rounds of each of the five sections will be tabulated and placed first through sixth. Each winner will receive a special award. Riders will ride for ribbons in each section and may participate in a victory gallop (or trot at the 18" height). Formal attire for the Classic is encouraged but is not required. Rider/horse combination may not compete in more than ONE CLASSIC. Entry fee \$25.

HUNTER DERBY: the Derby is a two round class. The first, "Classic round" will receive a base score plus 1 bonus point for each high option taken. The top 10 horses/ponies will return for a second "Handy" round. The second round will also receive a base score plus 1 point for each high option taken as well as bonus points for handiness. Combined scores will determine placings. 1-8 will receive ribbons and 1-6 will receive ETHJA points. There must be 4 entries to fill the class. The rounds may be ridden at 2', 2'6" or 3' with option jumps at 2'6", 3', or 3'3". Class to be contested in the ring and in the adjacent field over appropriate hunter type fences. For complete rules and specifications, see the HUNTER DERBY on the ETHJA website. Entry fee \$25.

EQUITATION CLASSES

LEAD LINE EQUITATION: Open to riders six years old and under. To be shown in-hand (led) at the walk by a competent handler of any age. To be judged on position in the saddle, use of aids, familiarity with and comfort on the animal. No ETHJA points and no entry fee.

GROUND RAIL EQUITATION: Open to amateur and junior riders who have not shown over fences 18" or higher. Courses must be trotted. Canter will be severely penalized. Riders may only cross enter the Cross Rail Equitation. To be judged on the rider's position and ability to effectively control their animal.

CROSS RAIL EQUITATION: Open to amateur and junior riders who have not shown over fences higher than 18". Courses must be mainly trotted. Canter will be penalized. Under saddle to walk/trot only. To be judged on position and rider's ability to effectively control their animal. Riders may cross enter the GROUND RAIL DIVISION and under-saddle classes (only) for which they are otherwise qualified. Fences under 18".

BEGINNER RIDER EQUITATION: Open to riders eligible for Beginner Rider Hunter. See those specifications under HUNTER CLASSES. To be judged on Equitation. Fences: 18".

2' EQUITATION: Open to short and long stirrup riders. May cross enter any other equitation division otherwise qualified for. To be judged on Equitation. Fences 2'.

14 & UNDER EQUITATION: Open to riders 14 and under on horses or ponies. Fences 2' or 2'6".

15-17 & ADULT AMATEUR EQUITATION: Open to riders 15-17 or adult amateurs. Fences: 2'6" or 3'.

ETHJA CHILDREN'S MEDAL: Open to junior riders on horses. To be shown over a course of fences with at least two changes of direction. A flat phase is required and shall count 25%. Further testing from USEF 1-12 may be requested at the judge's discretion. The top ten qualifiers will be eligible for a special ETHJA-sponsored Medal Finals at the end of the season. Fences: 2'6" or 3'.

ETHJA ADULT AMATEUR MEDAL: Open to adult amateur riders on horses. Same specifications as above. Fences 2'6" to 3'.

ETHJA PONY MEDAL: Open to junior riders on ponies. Same specifications as above. Ponies to jump 2' or 2'6".

MISC & PLEASURE CLASSES

PLEASURE: Open to all riders on horses or ponies. To be judged as a pleasurable ride, with manners and attitude to be taken into consideration.

BEGINNER HORSEMANSHIP: No ETHJA points. Not a part of any other division. Designed to be a fun extra class for any rider. Riders will mainly walk and will complete several "tasks" (and may have the help of one ground person). To walk through a "grid", back, demonstrate a 2 point position, walk over a ground rail, maneuver to their helper and receive a baton (crop) and drop the baton into a bucket or other identified space, dismount and lead their animal. All riders completing all elements of the "test" to receive a special prize.

RED/BLUE WARM-UP: Open to any horse/pony/rider combination. The judge will award a red ribbon for good rounds and a blue ribbon for excellent rounds, at his/her discretion. Red, blue or no ribbon will be awarded to each rider immediately after the completion of their round. **Multiple rounds** may be ridden (and paid for) as time permits.

HUNTER CLASSES

MINI HUNTER: Open to all riders on horses or ponies. Fences at 18" or 2' over regular courses with a change of direction. No penalty for trotting on course. Under-saddle class to walk/trot only. In order to retain BEGINNER RIDER status, Beginner Riders may NOT show at 2'.

BEGINNER RIDER HUNTER: To be shown over a simple hunter course including small flower boxes, walls and gates with a change of direction on course. To be held in the main show ring. Open to beginner riders on horses or ponies who *have not shown over fences higher than 18"* prior to the horse show. Riders may not show in the Lead Line class. Flat class to walk and trot only. Courses may be cantered with no penalty for trotting on course or for simple changes of lead. To be judged as a hunter class with emphasis on a rider's control and consistency in rhythm on course and suitability to the pony. Riders may cross enter other over fences classes with fences 18" or lower as well as any other under-saddle class for which they are otherwise eligible. Fences 18".

SHORT STIRRUP HUNTER: Open to riders twelve years of age and under on ponies in their first or second year of showing over fences 2' or higher. Pony/rider combination may not cross enter the pony Hunter Division. Fences 2'.

LONG STIRRUP HUNTER: Open to any rider in their first or second year of showing over fences 2' or higher who is either: riding a horse; or is riding a pony and is older than twelve years of age. Riders may not cross enter the Short Stirrup Hunter Division. Fences 2'.

SCHOOLING HUNTER: Open to all riders on horses or ponies. Fences at 2' or 2'6". Horses may NOT show in both the 2' and the 2'6" section. Each will receive a separate championship and reserve. However, points in both division will accrue to the ETHJA SCHOOLING HUNTER DIVISION.

PRE-CHILD/ADULT HUNTER: Open to children and adult amateur riders on horses and ponies. Adults may ride ponies. Divisions will be split if there are sufficient entries. Fences 2'6".

PONY HUNTER: Open to junior riders on ponies. Pony/rider combination may not cross-enter the Short Stirrup Hunter Division. Small ponies to jump 2', large ponies to jump 2'6", medium ponies to jump 2' or 2'6".

GREEN HUNTER: Open to horses and ponies in their first or second year of showing over fences exceeding 2'. Adults may ride ponies. Fences 2', 2'6" or 3'.

FIESTA HUNTER: Open to any rider on horses and ponies. Adults may ride ponies. No ETHJA points. Fences 2'.

CHILDREN'S HUNTER: Open to junior riders on horses. Fences 3'.

ADULT AMATEUR HUNTER: Open to adult amateur riders on horses. Fences 3'.

LOW HUNTER: Open to any rider on horses or ponies. Fences 3'
